- 4:30PM: House and Senate staff brought the group together and began by discussing the Legislative Council Committee's Agenda for Friday, April 26.
- 4:35PM: Members and staff discussed the letter interim committee requests on the agenda for the Legislative Council Committee's meeting:
  - Speaker McCluskie provided context on special education funding in the state of Colorado and the interplay with federal law.
  - Senate staff provided context on interim committee request #003 regarding American Indian Affairs.
  - Majority Leader Rodriguez shared about work being conducted on artificial intelligence in the state relative to interim committee request #001.
  - Representative Amabile shared out the work that the Treatment of Persons with Behavioral Health Disorders in the Criminal and Juvenile Justice Systems Interim Committee has done over the years relative to interim committee request #005.
